DOCUMENTATION OF GEORGIA RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

Effective January 2012, all new and re-entry students must request to receive the **In-State Tuition rate**. This request is made by responding “**Yes**” to “**Request In-State Tuition**” on the students Admission Application or Re-Entry Application.

To receive the **In-State Tuition rate**, applicants must present evidence of residency in the state of Georgia for a period of one year prior to the start of the term for which they are requesting the **In-State-Tuition rate**.

Until a determination has been made regarding eligibility for the In-State-Rate, students will be classified at the **Out-of-State-Tuition rate**, which is two times that of the **In-State Tuition rate**.

The following indicators may be considered when determining documenting the Georgia residency of an individual; but this list should not be considered all-inclusive:

- Georgia State Income Tax Return.
- Georgia address on Federal Income Tax Return.
- Georgia automobile title registration and Ad Valorem taxes receipt.
- Georgia Driver’s License or Georgia ID Card, and date of issuance.
- Georgia Voter Registration Card and date of issuance.
