MGTC offers refresher courses for FAA Airframe and Powerplant (A&P) License that include classroom training, all required written tests, and hands-on. **The classroom training, required written tests, and hands-on are seven days in length.** Oral and Practical Exams will be scheduled beginning the day following the completion of the courses and administered by **our own resident Designated Mechanic Examiner (DME).**

- **Two (original) FAA Form 8610-2 authorizations for the written tests need to be obtained from the FAA prior to course start.**
