Stop by the CAREER CENTER located in the A Building room A125. We offer assistance with your job search and will proofread resumes and cover letters as well. We also offer Career Workshops that assist students in their job search.

GO TO www.middlegatech.edu and look under “CURRENT STUDENTS” for the “CAREER SERVICES” web page. There, you will find hot links to web sites that list available jobs in all programs. Just above those links, you may also log in (using your student e-mail user name and password) to see the current jobs that are listed with the college. On the bottom left side of the web page is a link to a listing of Temporary Agencies that can assist in finding employment.

As always we encourage all MGTC students to register with the Department of Labor, www.dol.state.ga.us for employment seeking purposes as well as career guidance and job search resources. Once on the DOL web site, look just above Commissioner Michael Thurmond’s picture and click on “Site Index”.
